The Sackler Hall

The Sackler Hall is defined by London's only fully commissionable digital ellipse. At 48 linear metres and with integrated plasma screens your event can be enhanced by anything from its most simple showstate as a twinkling chandelier to a bespoke commission with dynamic film integration or interactive social media features.

With a capacity of 350 for seated dining or 500 for drink receptions, it is flexible enough to work equally well for award ceremonies, product launches, screenings and other presentations.
