

# Memory Matchers

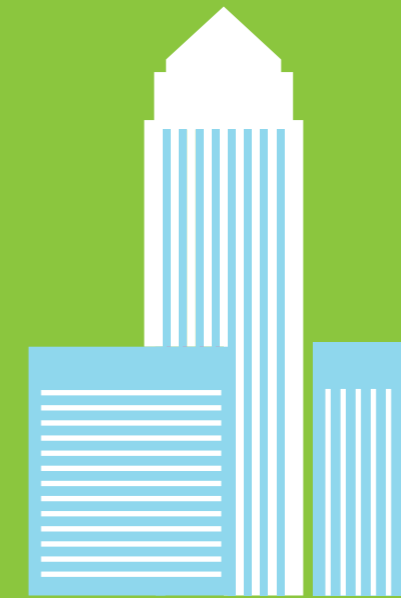
## The rules of the game are!
