#### 1. Key updates

NEW Government sets out next steps for living with COVID: 29/03

**NEW** Covid 19 update: written ministerial statement: 29/03

**NEW** New guidance sets out how to live safely with COVID-19: 01/04

- New guidance outlines free COVID-19 tests will continue to be available to help protect specific groups now that free testing for the general public has ended.
- Plans in place to enable rapid testing response should a new health threat emerge, such as a new variant of concern emerge.
- The government has removed the current guidance on voluntary COVID-status certification in domestic settings and no longer recommends certain venues use the NHS COVID Pass.
- The government has removed the health and safety requirement for every employer to explicitly consider COVID-19 in their risk assessments.
- The Coronavirus Statutory Sick Pay Rebate Scheme has now closed. The last date for submitting or amending a claim was 24 March 2022.

Businesses to benefit from over £700m government funding to local authorities: 07/01 Businesses urged to apply for £850m still available in COVID-19 support grants: 10/02

- One-off grants up to £6,000 per premises for hospitality and leisure businesses in England
- Devolved administrations will receive around £150m of funding; around £80m for Scottish Government, £50m for Welsh Government and £25m for Northern Ireland Executive.

<u>Local Restrictions Support Grants and Additional Restrictions Grant: updated 30/12</u> <u>Recovery Loan Scheme: updated 27/10</u>

- Finance up to £10m per business. Government guarantees 80% of the finance to lender.
- Open until 30 June 2022.

# Cultural Relief Rate Rises: Museums and Galleries Exhibition Tax reliefs: 27/10

• Temporary increase in the headline rates of relief for Museums and Galleries Exhibition Tax Relief for expenditure from 27 October 2021, gradually reduced to normal by 1 April 2024.
