We would like you to think about how you can all reduce our impact on the environment by making choices. As a visitor we believe you have a very important role to play in helping us to conserve our natural assets and become a more sustainable destination.

Here are our recommended tips on how you can help:

- Recycle maps: Picked up a map today? Please hand this back to our reception desk, enabling us to print less and re-use these maps for our future guests.
- Permanent maps: We also have laminated Maps available ask at our Front Desk for these.
- What's the greenest way you can get to the Museum of London?
 We have 50 Barclays Hire Scheme Bikes just under the Museum for public use, you don't have to be pre-registered and there are plenty of docking stations in Zone 1 of London.
 By using a bike instead of motorised transport you are helping lowering green house gas emissions into the atmosphere.
- Where did you purchase your Lunch from? Our benugo cafés use locally sourced produce and fair trade coffee. In London there are many Markets where you can buy Locally sourced food, why not give the London Farmers Market a try on www.lfm.org.uk/faq/
- **General recycling:** when you have waste or anything you would like to throw away from clothes to food think about whether or not it's reusable! You never know!
