This session will provide you with some more advanced video editing techniques, using the free programme '[HitFilm Express](#)'. This session is for those who already have a very basic understanding of video editing, either using programmes like iMovie or Windows Movie Maker, or through apps on phones / tablet devices. You will learn techniques such as:

- Trimming, cutting and overlaying audio / video
- Inserting transitions, images and text into videos
- Adding captions into videos and much more
